

PERSONAL DATA & COOKIES POLICY

The policy below details the data protection and cookies policy of Moët Hennessy Nederland with regard to personal data provided on the website www.Veuve-clicquot.nl

The Company respects your concerns regarding the confidentiality of personal information and data provided by you. By providing your personal information and data, you consent to the use, analysis and, where applicable, disclosure of such information under the terms and conditions outlined below.

1. **GENERAL INFORMATION**

The Company may collect personal data via the Site from users in relation notably with documents or services request (eg last & first name, e-mail address, age).

Any personal data you may be providing the Company with for the use of certain services is governed by the French law n°78-17 "Informatique et Libertés" dated 6 January 1978 (amended).

2. **RIGHT TO ACCESS, CORRECT AND DELETE DATA AND TO OBJECT TO DATA PROCESSING**

3. **MANAGEMENT OF PERSONAL DATA**

3.1 Purpose of data collection

The Company collects your personal data via the Site only for the following purposes:

- sending information about the Company and its activities and, with your consent, advertising or business prospecting messages,
- statistics, studies and analysis, marketing, improvement of the Site, products and services of the Company,

Mandatory information must be entered in the information fields marked with an asterisk in the data collection forms. If these fields are not completed, we are unable to address your query or to provide the services requested.

3.2 Retention of data

Data is retained for a period appropriate to the purposes for which it was collected and is, in any event, destroyed at the end of a six (6) month period unless for the cases outlined below in which data will be destroyed:

1 month after you unsubscribe from newsletter and/or press releases,

3.3 Data recipients

The Company is the recipient of the data. The Company may communicate your personal data to third parties only provided that:

- you have given your prior consent to such communication to a third party, and/or,
 - the Company has to share such information with third parties in order to provide the products or service you have requested, and/or,
 - the Company is required by a judicial authority or any other administrative authority to provide it with such information.

For the purposes (i) of technical management of the storage of your personal data and (ii) of managing the treatment activities, your data will be stored on a centralized basis on servers hosted by our provider:

3.4 Data security and privacy

Microsoft Internet Explorer 5:

1. Go to "Tools", then "Internet Options".
2. Click on the "Security" tab.
3. Select "Internet", then click on "Custom Level".
4. Under "cookies", select the option you want.

Netscape 6.x and 7.x:

1. Click the "Edit" menu, then "Preferences".
2. Privacy and security.
3. Cookies.

Firefox:

1. Go to "Tools", then "Options".
2. Click on the "Privacy" setting.

Safari 3.x for Mac OS X:

1. Click the "Edit" menu.
2. Click the "Preferences" option.
3. Click the "Security" option.
4. Click "Display cookies".
